

TAPE MOUNTED DIMENSIONAL LETTERS

Step 1:



Place paper pattern in the location that you want.

Step 2:



Measure to make sure the pattern is level to a "known" level surface.


Step 3:



Place tape on the left & right side of design then cut near bottom of letters as shown. Then fold up the top sheet leaving the bottom pattern of the letters you want to install.

Step 4:





The easiest way to place letters will be to place the ones that have flat bottoms or 2 or more points such as the letters n,m,L, etc... After you place these, place the curved letters such as letters c,e,s etc... by visually aligning them to the surrounding letters.

Step 5:



aced, gently remove the

Once all letters are placed, gently remove the pattern from under the letters. The letters should not adhere to the pattern as the letters' tape should have a gap at the bottom to allow for this per the example. Once the pattern is removed you can remove any protective coating if present.

Step 6:



Next, work your way up to the next set of letters, numbers and/or logos.

Step 7:



Repeat the steps for letter placement. Once all letters are arranged it is time for the curved letters or logo placement.

Step 8:



Step back frequently to make sure the job is looking proper and level.

Step 9:



Once all letters are placed remove the pattern.

Step 10:



Placement of lines can be done with ease using the same method. Sometimes cutting right along the bottom line as long as it is visible for alignment is the easiest way to get it done quickly. Lines close to letters should be done last so to not interfere with the letter placement later on.

Step 11:



Next place your logo and any registration marks.

Step 12:



Take time to clean and/or polish your work. Stand back for last final inspection to make sure it is perfect.
